A NEW ADDITION TO THE WOODSTOCK RANGE...



If you happen to be in the Vale, do call into Woodstock Cellar Door and taste the latest addition to the Woodstock range - **The Woodstock 'The OCTOgenarian' Grenache Tempranillo.**

For decades our neighbours tended to our frugal Grenache vines on sandy soils on the Woodstock Estate, McLaren Vale. Commonly referred to as 80 year old vines, or "Perpetual Octogenarians", their pedigree of quality became more evident over the decades. When the opportunity arose to become the next custodians of more of these meagre cropping, gnarly vines, the Collett family embraced them in 1988. We nurture these rarely respected Octogenarians and enjoy their lasting characters...

Made traditionally from chiefly low yielding Grenache vines, this 2010 vintage captures the aromatic cherry and berry fruits of the Grenache. The addition of 10% Tempranillo provides savoury tannins, a dash of soft Shiraz and a hint of leafy Cabernet Sauvignon adds spice and complexity.

This wine is currently available at Woodstock Estate. Otherwise, look out for it in hotels, restaurants, wine bars and bistros throughout the country.
