Woodstock Winery is a small second generation, family owned Winery here in McLaren Flat. Our wines are designed to capture the essence of the region ensuring absolute quality all the way. This begins in our vineyards, through every step of winemaking, to the glass in front of you. We trust you will enjoy our selection of wines carefully crafted by our dynamic winemaking team of Scott Collett, Ben Glaetzer and Trevor Roether.

2010 Woodstock 'Mary McTaggart' Riesling **Estate Grown** **7** **28**

In honour of the Collett family matriarch, Mary McTaggart. A lover of all things aromatic, Mary started at Woodstock estate's flourishing herb garden, from which we source for parts of the coterie menu. The delicately perfumed Riesling grape made her favourite wine, and this scented example comes solely from a small north facing vineyard on the sandy slopes of the highest part of the estate.

This wine makes a fine companion to fresh seafood dishes, just how Mary enjoyed it. A delicate wine showing elegance and finesse with citrus, floral aromas and underlying mineral notes. Its lean natural acidity is appealing, ensuring the palate is clean, crisp and refreshing.

2009 Woodstock Riesling **Estate Grown** **6.5** **25**

This Riesling was made from 36 year old Estate Grown vines planted on sandy soils in a north facing vineyard. To ensure we captured the delicate flavours of the Riesling varietal while maintaining its natural acidity, the fruit was harvested in the cool of night. Only free-run juice was used to ensure intensity and purity of flavours.

The 2009 Riesling is a delicate wine displaying citrus notes, grapefruit pith and a Granny Smith acidity on the palate. With its lean natural acid structure, it will age gracefully for many years to come!

2011 Woodstock Semillon Sauvignon Blanc **McLaren Vale** **5.5** **22**

Planted in 1988 on rootstocks, this Semillon clone was specifically chosen for its tropical fruit character and zippy acidity. To ensure we get the best flavours from this variety, yields are deliberately kept low. Sauvignon Blanc sourced predominantly from selected cooler vineyards in McLaren Vale provide intensity and lift.

The 2011 vintage displays intense passion fruit, gooseberry & Guava aromatics which leap out of the glass. Refreshing traces of green apples, star fruit and lifted citrus notes are also evident. The Semillon provides a great platform for the complex tropical flavours, which are round and full, that are cleverly balanced by some lingering Grapefruit acidity on the finish.

2010 Woodstock Chardonnay **Estate Grown** **6.5** **25**

This single vineyard wine comes from a specially selected clone of the chardonnay variety and resides in our 'Creek Block' since 1981. The grapes are picked when the flavours are rich and the natural acidity is still high.

A fruit driven wine, showing hints of rock melon and peaches on the palate. There is a notable fruit purity and an underlying minerality which appeals. Subtle oak and food flavours enhance the mouth feel adding complexity. These flavours linger on the palate and finishes clean, with crisp acidity. Cellaring, for up to 7 years will greatly intensify the flavours adding complexity.

2011 Woodstock Grenache Rose **Estate Grown** **5.5** **22**

Made from 80 year old Grenache vines, the grapes are picked in the cool of the night and made to an easy drinking style. The crushed grapes are cold soaked for up to 24 hours to allow good colour and flavour. The skins are then lightly pressed and discarded while the juice ferments slowly until the desired level of natural residual sweetness is reached.

Bright crimson in colour, this wine is bursting with luscious summer berries on the nose and palate. Ripe strawberries, fresh raspberries, Turkish delight, rosewater and fairy floss all feature. It's natural acidity and sweetness is balanced, its finish is clean and crisp and utterly morish!

2010 Woodstock 'The Octogenarian' Grenache Tempranillo Estate Grown 8.5 35

For decades, we and our neighbours tended to our frugal Grenache vines on sandy soils at Blewitt Springs, McLaren Vale. Commonly referred to as 80 year old vines, or "Perpetual Octogenarians", their pedigree of quality became more evident over the decades. We nurture these rarely respected Octogenarians and enjoy their lasting characters. Made traditionally from chiefly low cropping Grenache grapes, the addition of Tempranillo for savoury tannins, plus a dash of soft Shiraz and a hint of leafy Cabernet Sauvignon adds spice and complexity.

Light cerise in colour with youthful violet hues, medium bodied in style and food friendly. Aromatic fruit of blood plums and bright red cherries coat the palate with a delicate touch of cinnamon and white pepper spice, supple yet textural.

2010 Woodstock Shiraz Cabernet McLaren Vale 5.5 22

This classic Australian blend is a rare gem comprising of 64% Shiraz and 36% Cabernet Sauvignon. The Shiraz provides sweet fruit, spice and middle palate weight while the Cabernet Sauvignon provides a sturdy backbone, good structure and slippery texture to the wine... a lovely synergy indeed.

A burst of juicy grape flavours showing plums, dark berries, black currants, a touch of pepper and spice. It is lush and lively displaying good harmony between 2 of Australia's most prominent varietals. Maturation in 2 and 3 year old American and French oak barrels adds complexity. It is clean and approachable with good intensity built around a fine tannin backbone.

2010 Woodstock Cabernet Sauvignon Estate Grown 7 28

Situated in the higher end of the Vale, Woodstock Estate is the perfect home for the Cabernet Sauvignon variety. Warm days and cool gully and sea breezes ensure the Cabernet fruit ripens well with lovely berry flavour and natural acidity which contributes to its beautiful structure.

Woodstock has enjoyed a good reputation for Cabernet since 1982. The 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon shows classic cabernet characters.. Blackcurrants, cassis, hints of dark green foliage, eucalypt and earth all feature with rhubarb notes and white cherries on the finish. The wine is juicy with good acidity and a firm tannin structure which will reward years of careful and patient cellaring.

2010 Woodstock Shiraz McLaren Vale 7 28

Being a vigorous red variety, we manage our Shiraz canopies carefully to ensure the best from our Shiraz fruit. The number of leaves is reduced to ensure perfect ripening of the berries and yields are deliberately kept low to ensure good flavour concentration. The fruit is de-stemmed and gently crushed with seeds and stalks removed. The wine sees a combination of French and American oak. Compared to many Shiraz's from the region, Woodstock is made to a more elegant fruit driven style.

The 2010 Shiraz has a deep vibrant cerise colour with purple hues. The nose displays savoury oak and dark cherries with hints of nutmeg on the finish. The Palate is coated by lush bursts of mulberries and spice, joined by youthful tannins and a firm acid structure. These young characteristics provide good structure for years to come, a classic illustration of a McLaren Vale Shiraz

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2010 Woodstock 'Pilots View' Shiraz**McLaren Vale****10 42**

Flying Spitfires during World War II, Douglas Collett A.M. was privileged to a pilot's eye view of the vineyards of Europe. Returning home, Doug saw the future for an Australian table wine industry, moving on from fortified styles. Equipped with animation, initiative and perseverance, Doug planted many vineyards and made wines in many regions. He loved the natural beauty and robust flavours of McLaren Vale, acquiring Woodstock Estate in 1973. Doug's own flight helmet represents the vision and passion of this inspirational man whose philosophy was "The glass is always half full... so let's fill it up!"

Sourced entirely from estate grown fruit, expect lots of dark berries fruits, pepper, spice and savoury fine grain tannins This Beautifully layered wine would make a fine companion to a juicy piece of steak... Just how Doug would have enjoyed it.

Woodstock 'The Stocks'**Single Vineyard Shiraz**

Named after a set of medieval wooden leg stocks, which stand in the town of Woodstock in Oxfordshire, England, historically used for the public punishment of the town folk who over-imbibed, "The Stocks" Shiraz is Woodstock's flagship wine. A replica of this leg stocks has been built at the entrance to Woodstock Wine Estate.

The 'Stocks Shiraz' is only produced in excellent vintages from the fruit of century old low yielding vines planted on the north face of the Woodstock Estate. This single vineyard which comprise of 31 rows, was planted in the early 1900's on sandy top-soil over a layer of clay on an ironstone base. The light coloured sand reflects the sun which guarantees optimum ripeness. McLaren Vale's typically warm days and cool nights, with sea and gully breezes make ideal growing conditions.

To ensure that this vineyard achieves maximum quality, the vines are inspected thoroughly during veraison. Exposed bunches are removed to prevent sun burn and the canopies reduced to ensure perfect ripening. Yields are deliberately kept low and the vineyard essentially dry grown resulting in intense concentration of flavour evident in this wine. The Shiraz fruit is harvested at night to capture and preserve the delicate flavours of the berries.

These grapes were then crushed, cold soaked for 24 hours before fermentation in small open vats. To ensure the excellent colour and ripe tannin structure so necessary for a wine built to age, each fermenter is hand plunged twice daily. The wine then aged in carefully selected French and American oak barrels in a temperature controlled room for 9 to 18 months. Each barrel is then tasted individually by winemakers Scott Collett and Ben Glaetzer and only the finest chosen to continue the lineage of Woodstock's flagship "The Stocks" Shiraz.

2009 Woodstock 'The Stocks' Shiraz**Single Vineyard Estate Grown****16.5 63**

Yields were lower in the 2009 vintage. A warm start followed by a cooler finish to the vintage resulted in a wine with good fruit concentration yet a touch elegant. On the nose dark berries, traces of cedar and spice, chocolate and earthy notes are evident. The palate is plush with good intensity and complexity of flavours that will continue to evolve and mellow in the glass as well as in the cellar in over the next decade.

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2009 Woodstock Botrytis Semillon (375ml) Blend of Regions 8 25

Nicknamed 'Miss Dicky, The Sticky' this is one of our favourites in the Woodstock stable. Made from Botrytis affected Semillon, this delightful wine is sure to win your heart.

Aromas of apricot and quondong jam, orange and mandarin peel set the scene for an explosion of luscious array of honey and citrus flavours on the palate. Some subtle nutmeg & spice is also detected ... a perfect balance of sweetness and acidity but finishing clean and leaving you wanting more!

2006 Woodstock Vintage Fortified Shiraz (375ml) McLaren Vale 8 25

Capturing the essence of old vine McLaren Vale Shiraz, the fruit for this wine is picked when fully ripe, usually around 16 Baume. Red winemaking techniques transform the grapes into wine. Pure grape spirit is added mid way through fermentation to ensure a level of natural sweetness is preserved.

A rich and powerful wine with a great tannin structure, silky yet chewy tannins! Drinks well now but will develop complexity with age.

Woodstock Muscat (375ml) McLaren Vale 8 25

A highly perfumed wine made from white and red Frontignac grapes. Grape selection and degree of ripeness are crucial decisions to ensure a fabulous Muscat. Very ripe to the point of raisin development is desired to ensure lusciousness in the final wine. Long term maturation in oak adds complexity.

An outstanding example of this wine style, displaying raisin characters on the nose with orange zest adding lift and a glimpse of Grandma's Christmas pudding making it an ideal partner for something sweet!

Woodstock Very Old Fortified (500ml) McLaren Vale 14 48

Traditionally known as Tawny Port, this wine is very special to Woodstock. A big portion of this blend was made by Doug Collett, the founder of this Estate. Like the Vintage Fortified, pure grape spirit is used to stop fermentation ensuring a desired sweetness level. The wine is then aged in small 200 – 300 litre oak casks. New wine is constantly blended to ensure consistency and freshness. Approximately 25 years old, Woodstock's Very Old Fortified is made from Grenache and Shiraz varieties.

A rich and intense coating of toffee and roasted almonds makes this a rewarding finish to any meal!
